**Bonus Points to be awarded to participants competing in both Spring2Summer and Wake Battle contests based on their finish in the Men's Open Pro division: First - 10 points, Second 8 points, Third 5 points – Highest points wins \$ 500 bonus, if there is a tie, money will be divided equally.*

Please note that WakeFactory has the right to cut classes, combine classes or add classes as they see fit. Classes may be dropped or added based on sign-up or participation.

We also reserve the right to move you up or down in a class based on your perceived skill level. This is at our discretion and is unchallengeable. Refunds will not be issued.

All riders must have a valid WWA membership to compete in the contest. If you do not have a current WWA membership you may purchase one when you sign-up for the contest.

If you are under 18 years of age you must have a parent signature to compete in the contest.

It is your responsibility to make your ride time. We are not responsible for you missing your ride time. You may be unable to hear announcements in the boat line and it is suggested you stay on shore until after you have competed. The designated jetskis are there for the safety of the riders and are not a taxi service to and from the boatline. No refunds will be issued for missing your ride time.

Registration closes one hour prior to the estimated start time of each division. It is solely up to Wakefactory's discretion whether anyone will be allowed to register after that time.

We suggest you register Friday night to avoid any issues.
